

- 1. CURL ONE LIGHTWEIGHT PLASTIC CARRIER BAG ROUND INTO A DOUGHNUT SHAPE AND WRAP IN MASKING (OR NORMAL STICKY) TAPE
- TAKE A SECOND BAG, TEAR IN HALF LONGWAYS AND WRAP ROUND DOUGHNUT UNTIL IT LOOKS ABOUT THE RIGHT THICKNESS






WRAP THE DOUGHNUT IN


AS SMOOTH AS POSSIBLE

MASKING TAPE SO THAT IT IS





- COAT THE TOP OF THE DOUGHNUT IN A LIBERAL LAYER OF GLUE GUN GLUE SO THAT SOME DRIBBLES DOWN THE SIDE.
- DO ONE HALF AT A TIME, BUT COAT THE SECOND HALF WHILE THE FIRST IS STILL HOT SO THAT THE EDGES MERGE. DON'T PUT TOO MUCH ON OTHERWISE IT WILL RUN EVERYWHERE. NOTE: GLUE **GUN GLUE IS HOT AND WILL** BURN IF IT GETS ON YOU







- (IDEALLY) SPRAY THE TOP OF THE DOUGHNUT WITH BRIGHT PINK PAINT. IT DOESN'T MATTER IF YOU GET OVER-SPRAY ON THE REST OF THE DOUGHNUT, BECAUSE YOU WILL BE PAINTING OVER THAT LATER. MAKE IT A NICE THICK LAYER.
 - THEN WHILE THE SPRAY PAINT IS STILL WET...
- SPRINKLE SUGAR STRANDS OVER THE TOP OF THE DOUGHNUT SO THAT THEY STICK IN THE WET PAINT. IF YOU DON'T HAVE STRAY PAINT THEN YOU CAN GET THIS EFFECT BY PAINTING WHITE GLUE (PVA OR ELMERS, THAT DRIES CLEAR) OVER YOUR PINK PAINT AND SPRINKLING THE SUGAR STRANDS ON TO THAT WHILE IT IS WET

NOW MAKE THE BITE MARK AND PAINT THE DOUGHNUT




8. CUT THROUGH GLUE GUN GLUE WITH A STRONG CRAFT KNIFE AND THEN CUT THE TAPE AND PLASTIC BAG DOUGHNUT WITH A PAIR OF SCISSORS OR LONG THIN KNIFE IN A SAWING ACTION.

> IF YOU DON'T WANT A BITE THEN SKIP TO STEP 14.



SEAL THE CUT FACE WITH A THIN LAYER OF GLUE GUN GLUE.



10. TO MAKE THE FILLING, BUILD UP A BIG BLOB OF GLUE GUN **GLUE**



11. THE BLOB WILL WANT TO SAG OR DRIP, SO KEEP TURNING DOUGHNUT AS IT SETS (SEE NEXT TWO STEPS)



12. BUILD UP THE BLOB OVER TWO OR THREE GOES, A BIG BLOB OF HOT GLUE TAKES MUCH LONGER TO SET AND WILL BE HARD TO CONTROL.



13. THERE ARE TWO BLOBS OF FILLING, DO ONE SIDE AT A TIME, ADDING MORE GLUE AND LETTING IT SET UNTIL IT **LOOKS RIGHT**



14. PAINT THE SIDES OF THE DOUGHNUT WITH ACRYLIC PAINT. PAINT THE SIDES SLIGHTLY DARKER THAN THE BOTTOM. MIX UP A LIGHT BROWN (USE MORE YELLOW AND WHITE IN THE MIX) USE YELLOW OCHRE IF YOU HAVE IT.



15. PAINT THE BREAD PART OF THE BITE A LIGHTER SHADE OF BROWN THAN THE OUTSIDE OF THE DOUGHNUT AND THEN PAINT THE BLUEBERRY FILLING A NICE RICH PURPLE



Homer's D'oh-nut Trophy


NOW MAKE THE STAND AND FINISH THE TROPHY




16. USE A DISPOSABLE PLASTIC FOOD TRAY FOR THE TROPHY BASE STAND




17. NEATLY CUT OFF ANY EXTRA FLANGE OR RIM SO THAT THE EDGES GO STRAIGHT DOWN TO THE BASE



18. PLACE ON A PIECE OF CORRUGATED CARD OR FOAMBOARD AND DRAW ROUND



19. CUT OUT THE CARDBOARD AND GLUE IT INTO THE TOP OF THE TRAY



20. CUT A SMALL RECTANGLE OF BOARD FOR THE PLAQUE, CUT WITH AN ANGLED EDGE FOR THE BEST EFFECT

> USE TWO SPOTS OF GLUE GUN GLUE FOR THE SCREW HEADS

SPRAY OR PAINT WITH GOLD



21. GLUE GUN GLUE PLAQUE TO FRONT OF BASE



22. CUT A LOLLY STICK OR COFFEE STIRRER TO THE RIGHT LENGTH MAKE A HOLE IN THE TOP OF BASE AND POKE LOLLY STICK THROUGH. MAKE IT A GOOD FIT



23. POKE LOLLY STICK THROUGH BASE CARD, WHEN YOU SEE BULGE, USE CRAFT KNIFE TO MAKE HOLE IN THE RIGHT PLACE AND SECURE STICK WITH BLOB OF GLUE



18. POKE LOLLY STICK INTO SOFT PART OF DOUGHNUT, AFTER MAKING A SMALL HOLE WITH A CRAFT KNIFE
